



# Lead Safe Work Practices Training Course

There will be additional lead trainings offered in Albany, Rensselaer, and Schenectady counties in 2010. Please call the contacts below for more information.

This training class will be presented at **no cost to attendees**. Those encouraged to participate include: property owners, handymen, contractors, maintenance workers, code inspectors, painters, "do it yourselfers", and staff with state and local municipal agencies, community and social service organizations, and professional associations.

The goal of this program is to teach attendees lead-safe work practices and the strategies for implementing them. Many homes built before 1978 contain lead-based paint, so it is important that renovation, remodeling and repair activities use methods that reduce and control dust and debris created during work. Even a small amount of dust can pose a serious health risk to children and families.

This Lead Safe Work Practices training course is based on EPA's and HUD's previous model courses in lead-safe work practices. This course satisfies HUD requirements for interim controls training in federally assisted housing.

The curriculum has an introduction and five instructional modules, each with options for interactive exercises. The course duration is 8 hours, including the test.
