- 2) Attend this training program on March 7 & 8, 2012 to review the manual and prepare for the exam.
- 3) Return to CCE Albany County on March 23, 2012 to take the exam.

QUALIFICATIONS:

In order to qualify for this program, you must have graduated from a recognized 2 or 4 year college with a degree in a horticultural related field OR completed three years of experience in the horticultural industry. All of your qualifying education/experience should be listed on your application.
